**7 October 2023**

Request received and referred to LNR Management group. A volunteer wishes to set up a nature camera in a secret location in the nature reserve to see what kind of footage it records. This is for night time to see what kind of wildlife we get there. Decision whether to allow this required from PC.

**31 Oct 2023**

Tyne Valley Woodlands have now completed pruning of the remaining oaks along the east boundary of the nature reserve adjacent to the allotments .

Yesterday some of the stems on the 10-stem willow below Tyne View were pollarded. There were 3 more still to do. The willow adjacent fell over in Storm Agnes and is lying along the informal riverside path. Could still do with cutting the growths down to the pollarding point and chopping up the main stem. In my opinion, it is no serious problem at the moment and regular walkers have been making a path higher up, above the water and the fallen tree.

**1 November 2023**
